

Peace unto you brothers and sisters,

The world admits that Ham the son of Noah was a dark skinned person. What the word of God proved was he was not the only one, but also his brothers Japheth and Shem. Knowing that Ham's skin color is NOT a consequence of a curse allows us without prejudice to receive a better understanding of the scriptures. Psalms 105:23 "Israel also came into Egypt; and Jacob sojourned in the land of Ham." Everyone knows that the land of Egypt is in what is known today as Africa. When the nations were separated (Genesis chapter 11) the impact of Nimrod continued with the Egyptians. Concerning the sons Phut the Libyans, their achievements as an ally of Egypt and their impact in Europe causes whites to try to claim them as part of their race. COLOR IN THE BIBLE BLACKNESS OF ISRAEL


From our youth we are taught that all Africans are black, yet in movies such as the Ten Commandments we are shown white actors playing the role of the Egyptians. Although Hollywood would portray this picture to you, do not be deceived. For all ancient historians have documented the physical traits of the Egyptians; even the Egyptians left behind portraits of themselves for us to **view**.

The Egyptians

Note the description given by the scholars state: **Egyptian wall painting.** This wall painting from the fourth dynasty (ca. 2700 B.C.) depicts the Egyptians as a brown-skinned people with stiff, dark hair.

The indigenous people of Egypt are descendants of Mizraim son of Ham. Hence the reason they called themselves Kemet which means black country after their forefather Ham (pronounced in the Hebrew as Cham/Kham).

Today Hollywood and white supremacist historians try to blur that fact. They like to ignore ancient Egypt's history of a black civilization for the much later Macedonian (Greek) Egypt (ca. 323 B.C.) established by Alexander the Great. When he replaced the ruling class with Ptolemy I (Soter). Today Egypt is ruled by Arabs.






You may be asking yourself, why is the skin color of the Egyptians important? **2nd Co-rinthians 4:4** "In whom the god of this world hath blinded the minds of them which believe not, lest the light of the glorious gospel of Christ, who is the image of God, should

shine unto them." The light of the glorious gospel is that you are a special people, the REAL Jews, to whom pertains the promises of eternal life. As the scripture states this world is geared to blind the minds of our people from remembering the name of Israel.

Exodus 2:17 "And the shepherds came and drove them away: but **Moses** stood up and helped them, and watered their flock." **Verse 18:** "And when they came to Reuel their father, he said, How is it that ye are come so soon to day?" **Verse 19:** "And they said, An **Egyptian** delivered us out of the hand of the shepherds, and also drew water enough for us, and watered the flock."

Moses an Israelite from the tribe of Levi, was always confused from his birth for an Egyptian. Have you ever pondered upon this? How would Pharaoh's daughter raise Moses as her own if he was white? When Reuel's daughters met Moses they describe him to be as an Egyptian to their father. What does that mean? That the physical appearance of the Israelites could be compared to that of an Egyptian. Therefore Moses was a man of color (black) and not as Hollywood portrays him as a so called white man.

The Hebrews in Egypt as Slaves




Yet Moses was not the only Israelite confused to be an Egyptian in the Bible. Acts 21:37 "And as Paul was to be led into the castle, he said unto the chief captain, May I speak unto thee? Who said, Canst thou speak Greek?" Verse 38: "Art not thou that Egyptian, which before these days madest an uproar, and leddest out into the wilderness four thousand men that were murderers?" Verse 39: "But Paul said, I am a man which am a Jew of Tarsus, a city in Cilicia, a citizen of no mean city: and, I beseech thee, suffer me to speak unto the people."



Paul an Israelite from the tribe of Benjamin was also mistaken for an Egyptian. All the Israelites of every tribe were people of color, because the patriarchs were in physical appearance as the Egyptians. Joseph was sold into Egypt by his brothers and when they were come into the land to buy corn he spoke to them by an interpreter. **Genesis 42:23** "And they knew not that Joseph understood them; for he spake unto them by an interpreter." They did not recognize Joseph but thought him to be an Egyptian until he revealed himself unto them. **Acts 7:13** "And at the second time Joseph was made known

to his brethren; ..." If Joseph was a so called white man he would stand out from the rest of the Egyptians. Likewise when Jacob was buried the Canaanites mistakenly thought the Egyptians alone mourned for him.




Genesis 50:7 "And Joseph went up to bury his father: and with him went up all the servants of Pharaoh, the elders of his house, and all the elders of the land of Egypt," Verse 8: "And all the house of Joseph, and his brethren, and his father's house: only their little ones, and their flocks, and their herds, they left in the land of Goshen." Verse 9: "And there went up with him both chariots and horsemen: and it was a very great company." Verse 10: "And they came to the threshingfloor of Atad, which is beyond Jordan, and there they mourned with a great and very sore lamentation: and he made a mourning for his father seven days." Verse 11: "And when the inhabitants of the land, the Canaanites, saw the mourning in the floor of Atad, they said, This is a

grievous mourning to the Egyptians: wherefore the name of it was called Abelmizraim, which is beyond Jordan."



In this video, archeologist show a signet (ring) found in Egypt with the Biblical (Hebrew) name Jacob. This is evidence of what is recorded in **Genesis chapter 46** and **Exodus chapter 1**.

Notice the Canaanites did NOT say this is a grievous mourning to the Egyptians and the Hebrews. If the patriarchs were white they would have been able to distinguish them from the Egyptians. It is easy to see that the Hebrews could blend in with the Egyptians because of their skin color. With this conclusion we could understand why Jesus Christ's parents fled into Egypt from the face of Herod. Matthew 2:13 "And when they were departed, behold, the angel of the Lord appeareth to Joseph in a dream, saying, Arise, and take the young child and his mother, and flee into Egypt, and be thou there until I bring thee word: for Herod will seek the young child to destroy him." These scriptures are examples of what the god of this world would want you to be blinded of.
